

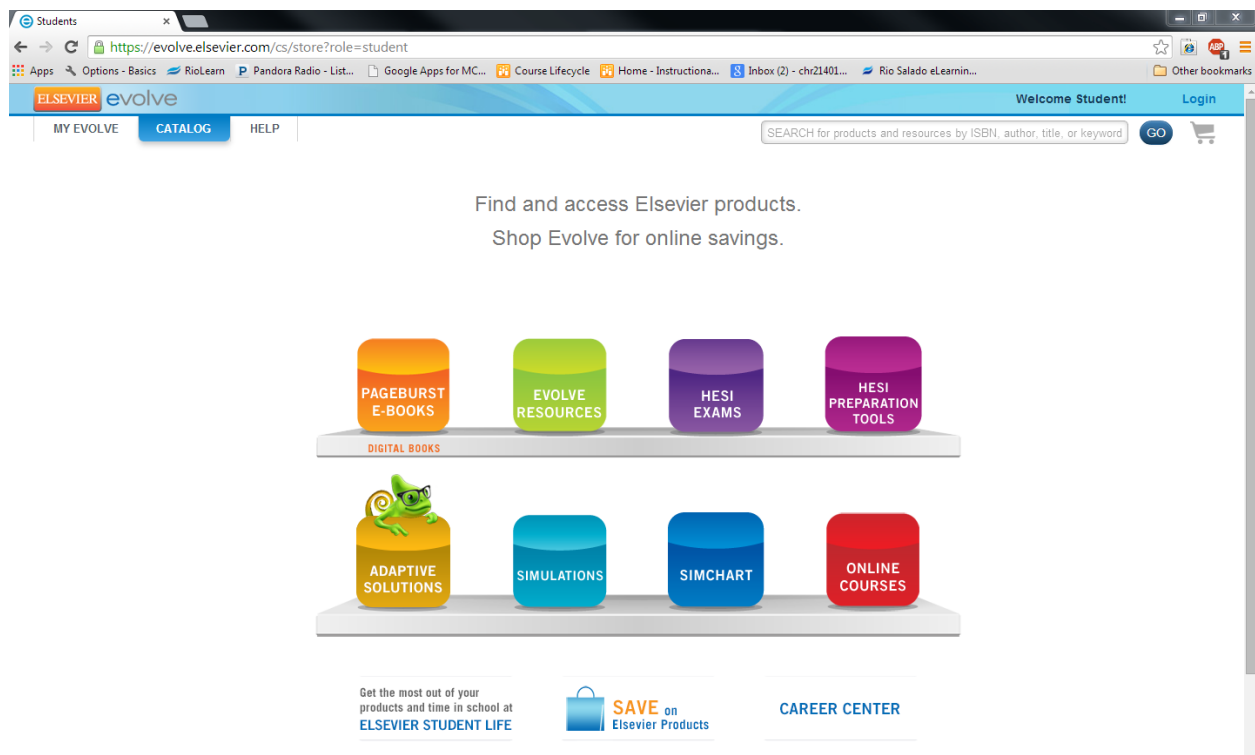

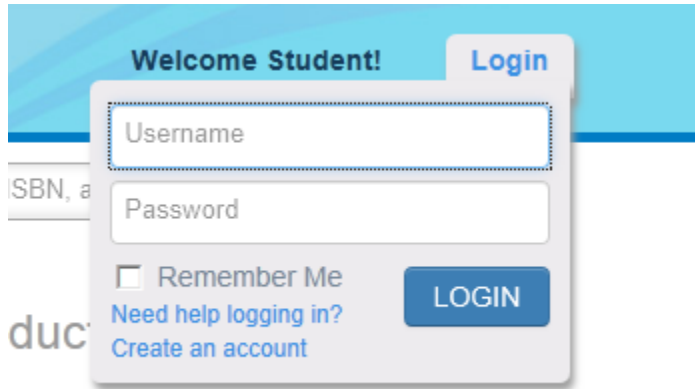
Evolve Self Enrollment Steps:

1. Go to <http://evolve.elsevier.com> and click Student if you are not already presented with the student page.

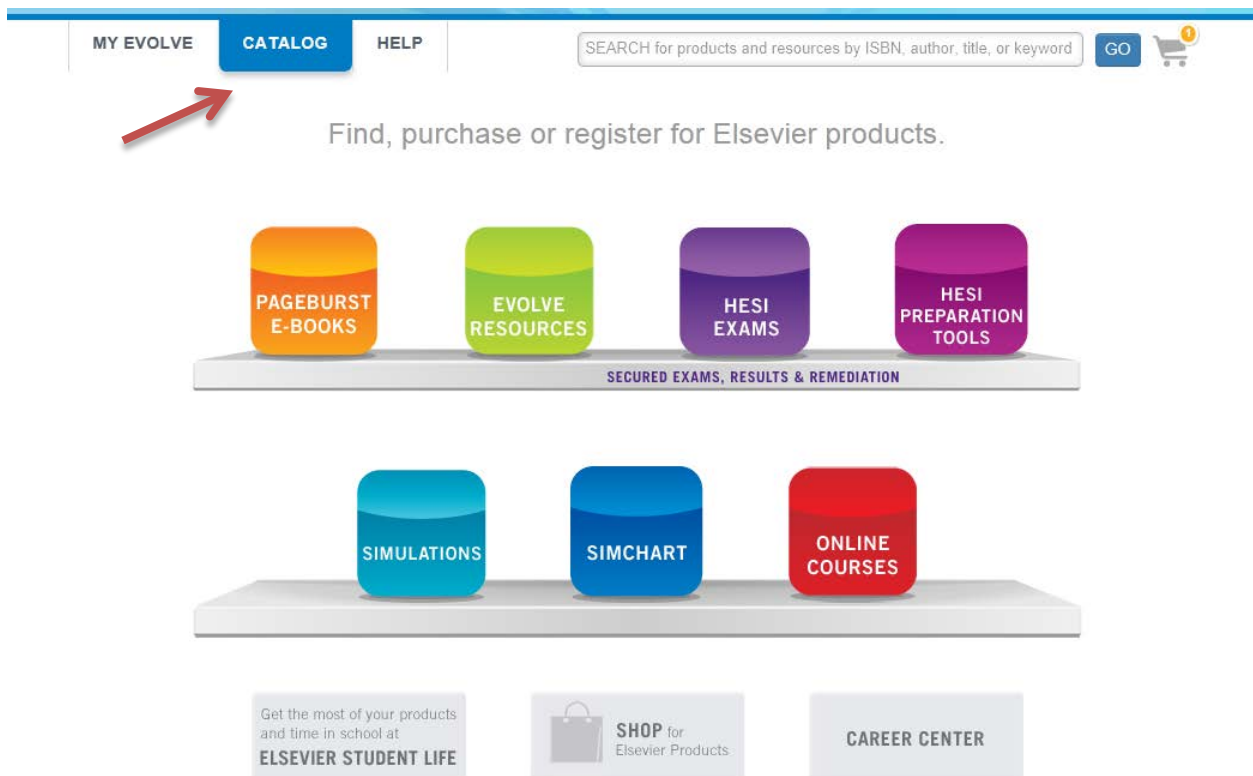

2. Click on **Login** and follow the instructions to create your student account (click on “Create an account”).



3. You should receive a “Welcome to Evolve” email with your student account information. Login in with your username and password. Then, click on the “Catalog” tab to find this screen:



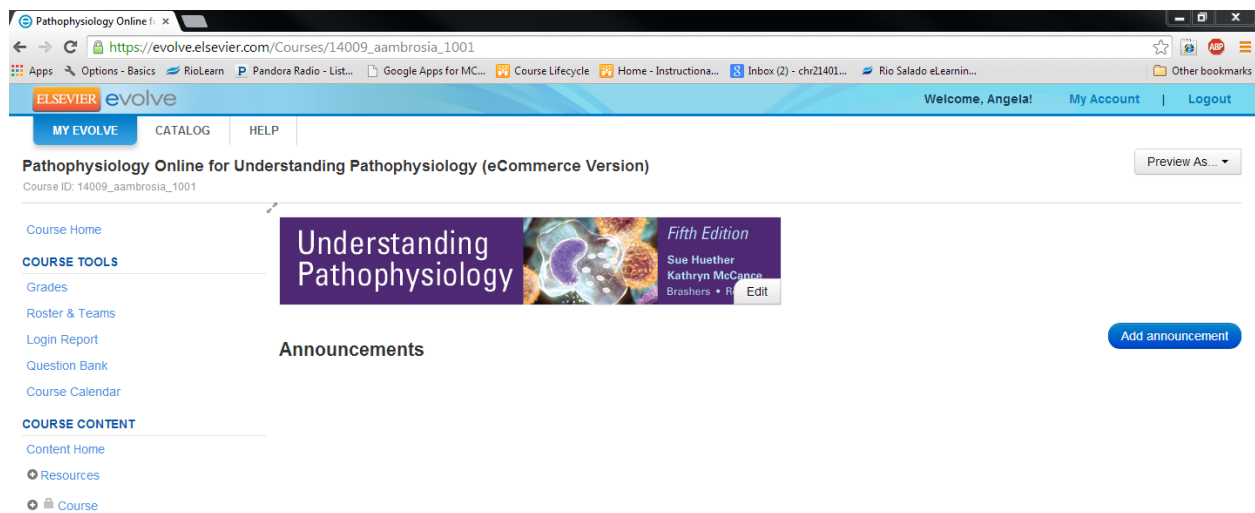
4. Click on “Online Courses”, then on “Enroll in your instructor’s course.”
5. Enter Course ID: **14009.aambrosia-1001** in the box and hit “Submit”.

6. Your textbook should appear. Click on “I have an access code:” radio button, then enter your access code (from your textbook), and click on “Apply”:
